Electrical safety is very important. To avoid getting an electric shock, remember Ergon Energy Man's **safety** tips:

- ◆ Stay safe. Only fly **kites** and planes in big open spaces like an oval or park, not near overhead powerlines.
- ◆ Electricity can be dangerous. Tell an adult if you see a **broken** or frayed electrical cord – it needs to be fixed by an electrician, or thrown out.
- ◆ Don't **climb** trees near powerlines. Touching a powerline can kill. Instead play in a park where there are no powerlines.
- ◆ Electricity can be dangerous. Powerpoints are not for playing with – don't **touch** them!
- ◆ Turn off lights and electrical items when you have finished with them – it saves money and can help reduce greenhouse gas emissions.
- ◆ Ask Mum or Dad to buy **Clean** Energy so your family can help the environment by supporting renewable **energy** projects like wind farms.
- ◆ Be careful after a storm – there could be fallen **powerlines** hidden in grass, branches and flooded creeks.
- ◆ **Water** and electricity don't mix. If you've got wet hands, don't touch **switches** or power points and stay safe.
- ◆ Little trees can grow into big trees. Be careful what you plant under powerlines.
- ◆ **Help** the environment. When air conditioning is on at home or school, put the blinds down and make sure you keep the doors and windows closed.
- ◆ Help the environment. Feel like a snack? Save power and keep the cold air in by thinking about what you'd like before you open the fridge door.
