

What we are doing

On 29th April, we will be commencing work at the back of the Ergon Depot, to connect the first of the 66,000-volt cables from the Garbutt substation to the surrounding electricity network. To complete this work safely, road closures and detours will be in place around the Garbutt substation project area during this time.


What to expect

During these works, road users and nearby businesses can expect the following:

- The construction of a large scaffold tower and work platform (see sample image)
 where electrical termination equipment will be installed on the underground
 cables from Garbutt Substation and connected to the overhead network at the
 top of the pole.
- Woolcock Street Service Road (green hashed area in below map), behind the Ergon depot, will be closed for a period of around 2 weeks from 29th April.
- Traffic will be permitted to exit Woolcock Street to access the Dalrymple Service Road under traffic control – see detour maps below.
- There will be no turning onto the Woolcock Service Road from Dalrymple Road to access Woolcock Street. To access Woolcock Street, traffic will be redirected via Hartley, Bolam and Langton Streets as per detour path on the maps.
