

Letter of Authorisation to Install Solar & Renewables for Embedded Network



Part of Energy Queensland

If your proposed installation is located within an Embedded Network, you must contact the Embedded Network Operator [the retail account holder of the parent NMI connected to the Distribution Network] to obtain approval prior to submitting your application.

Mandatory Documentation

You must provide the following with your application:

- Approval Letter from the Embedded Network Operator and;
- Audit documentation.

**** Applications submitted without these documents will be cancelled.**

Approval Letter Requirements

The letter of approval must be issued from the Embedded Network Operator and must include the following information:

Embedded Network Operator Details

The approval letter must include:

- Embedded Network Operator Business Name
- Postal address
- Contact person
- Email address
- Phone number
- Position title of the Embedded Network Operator issuing the approval
- Signature

Authorised Person Details

When providing authorised person details, ensure the following information is included, as applicable:

For individuals:

- Full Name
- Postal address
- Phone
- Email

For a company or organisation:

- Business name
- Contact person
- Postal address
- Phone
- Email

Installation Details

- Unit/townhouse number of the proposed installation
- Parent NMI
- Inverter Capacity
- Requested Export

Additional Requirements for Additional Systems

Are there existing solar/battery installations within this Embedded Network [entire site]?

Where you are installing an additional system/s within an Embedded Network, the approval email/letter must also include the following information in addition to the above;

- Total of existing inverter capacity on the entire site [kVA]
- Total of existing export on the entire site [kW]
