We're building a microgrid to improve the reliability of Jumbun's electricity supply

We're building a low voltage microgrid at Jumbun. The \$3 million project will improve the reliability of the electricity supply for the local Girramay, Jirrbal and Gulnay people in the Jumbun community.

We're helping to care for Country, too. The microgrid will store excess energy in a battery, which can be used when demand is high, meaning a more sustainable energy supply for Jumbun.

Construction of the Jumbun Microgrid is scheduled to commence in late 2025.
