A message from Ergon

"Update on the upcoming Solar Farm and Battery project scheduled to take place in Windorah.

The project stages for Windorah are as below (subject to tender submissions, legislative and project approvals):

- *Stage 1 - Solar Farm & Battery Tenders Released & Awarded: Dec 2023 – June 2024*
- *Stage 2 - Solar Farm Design and Build: June 2024 – Dec 2024*
- *Stage 3 - Battery Design and Build: April 2024 – Apr 2025*
- *Stage 4 - Ergon System Integration & Commissioning - Jan 2025 – June 2025*

Please note that there will be no disruption to the existing electrical supply during these works, and the system's reliability will be maintained with the retention of the current power station. If you have any questions or require further information, please feel free to contact us."
