Cranbrook substation upgrade

Since its establishment in 1972, the Cranbrook substation has served the community well.

Now, **53 years later**, standards, technology, and network capabilities have advanced.

While the substation has remained resilient, its infrastructure and equipment are reaching the end of their efficient operational lifespan.

To ensure the safe, efficient, and reliable delivery of power and to meet the growing electricity demand, we are investing in upgrades.

Cranbrook substation supplies power to approximately **4,800 customers**, but this number continues to increase as Townsville grows.

What is happening?

As part of this project, we will expand Cranbrook substation onto the adjacent Ergon-owned land, with a new, modern building designed to provide long-term reliability and meet future growth.

We will upgrade both the 11Kilovolt(kV) and 66Kilovolt(kV) network, including feeder lines, and an 11kV switchboard inside the existing substation.

What will the new substation look like?

Preparation works set to begin

To prepare for the upcoming substation upgrade, a variety of preliminary works will be carried out over the coming months. Local residents and businesses may notice increased activity around the site, including early-stage civil works within the substation grounds.

How long will the project take to complete?

The full substation upgrade is scheduled to be completed by December 2026. During construction project updates will be provided throughout the various stages.
